Addison County Pre-charge Protocol

- The officer is ready to cite a person for Criminal allegation that is eligible under the Addison County Pre-charge Program.
- Complete the fillable Notice of Pre-charge Referral to ACRJS with the person's information, give them a copy of the form.
- Complete the citation, do not fill in the date.
- Send the citation and the affidavit within 30 days to:

Addison Count Restorative Justices services 282 Boardman Street, Middlebury, VT 05753

- Upon successful completion of the program ACRJS will send the citation back to the officer Voided.
- Unsuccessful completion, ACRJS will notify the officer within 45 days if the Citation is being returned because of failure of the program. The citation will be returned to the officer with a letter stating the reason for failure.
- ACRJS will track all of the Pre-charge Cases and a meeting will be held to review the Pre-charge data and make revisions as needed to the program.
